Dear friends,

9th of September, which this year will mark the 75th anniversary of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea's proclamation, is approaching and we, foreign friends of the DPRK people, all eagerly want to celebrate the day. Not without a reason.

Firstly, this day is extremely important for dear to our hearts the people of DPRK. Seven and half decades ago, when President Kim II Sung founded the DPRK, 3 years after the liberation of the nation from colonial rule, fundamental turn was brought about in shaping Koreans' destiny. Not very long before that date, they had been forced to live like slaves under foreign occupation, but with the birth of the independent and democratic socialist state in Korea they became proud masters of their own country.

Secondly, establishment of the DPRK has great significance also directly to us, though we are foreigners. This is because the country constitutes a symbol of independence, justice and unyielding fight for the interests of the people, a beacon of light and hope, a source of incredible inspiration for progressive-minded human beings of different parts of the world.

The DPRK's enemies never cease their constant propaganda attacks against it, allocating millions of dollars to this smear campaign. Unfortunately these shameful efforts to defame the country have not a small impact and a lot of individuals, especially those from Western nations, built their views about the DPRK on heaps of propagandist lies. They were deceived. However, on the other hand, in spite of propaganda hostile toward the DPRK people, there are also ones who have more reliable knowledge. There are ones who did some objective research, ones who personally visited socialist Korea and their opinions on the issue are based on facts. Thus, there are many people around the globe who deeply admire the DPRK. And it is really very well-deserved admiration.

Today at the helm of the country stands, truly revered by his people and by friends of Korea, respected President of the State Affairs, Marshal Kim Jong Un. His outstanding, energetic leadership, hard, devoted work and politics that he practices, I would say are particularly worth noting. What can be said on the topic of his politics? Surely infinitely more than I can include in my short statement, but now I will briefly talk about some important points in this context.

Plenty of modern and beautiful constructions have been built for the people, including streets, villages or charming town of Samjiyon, as well as factories and enterprises furnished with cutting-edge equipment, innovative large-scale farms, all kind of magnificent public facilities serving various purposes, from healthcare and education to leisure. Less than 8 years have passed since then, but I recall this moment as I am much fascinated with new residential streets and other constructions that meanwhile have been built in Pyongyang, as well as in other parts of the country.

Marshal Kim Jong Un said that the Juche-oriented socialist architecture is, in essence, based on the principle of giving first and foremost importance to the masses of the people.

It is apparent, indeed, that in the DPRK architecture serves the masses of the people.

For instance, today the realization of the project of building 50 000 flats is underway in Pyongyang. Over 20 000 of them already have been built in the form of fabulous, modern, harmoniously composed streets of high-rise and super-high-rise apartment blocks, streets that have also all necessary public buildings and welfare service facilities, moreover much of the nice greenery around.

Foreign observers can be especially amazed by the fact that this kind of apartments were given to citizens by the state free of charge – after all, in other countries one would have to pay enormous sum of money to get such a pleasant space to live in. However, the DPRK stands out as a country that provides its people with free housing doesn't it sound like a dream for families living in capitalist countries around the world and struggling to gather money for a flat?

The construction boom can be witnessed also outside of the DPRK's capital city. New lovely rural houses are appearing in all parts of the country, giving joy to people receiving them from the state. Modern, colourful villages placed in the DPRK's mountainous and hilly landscape look delightful and delight of their residents is even more heartwarming. These all can be given to the people thanks to the DPRK's selfreliance, that make it possible for the country to energetically move forward, despite many roadblocks thrown in its path by formidable enemies.

The socialist Korea with its own resources and technology created and launched artificial earth satellites, produced indigenous plane, subway train or nice smartphones. It seems that the DPRK people can do anything they want, not only without any external help, but even in the harshest circumstances created by the forces hostile to them.

When I think of the horrible injustice of blockades and sanctions introduced against the Korean people – only because they chose their own way, because they want something better than the imperialists offered to them and are determined to defend it and to defend their country–I get emotional and feel bitter.

Obviously I am angry at these brigandish economic aggressions toward Koreans. Their country's legitimate foreign trade and cooperation is impeded by these heinous measures intended to hurt them. And the world undoubtedly is losing much without wide economic cooperation with the well-educated, creative and talented people of the DPRK. However, I am absolutely sure that the DPRK will always remain victorious, no matter how desperately its foes try to obstruct its development. Under the outstanding leadership of Marshal Kim Jong Un, the country has turned the enemies' sanctions into a good opportunity for bolstering up the self-development capabilities and the internal driving force.
